- Total moose licenses decreased by 70 to 404. All moose licensees and Unit E1E, E1W, E2, and E6 elk licensees may hunt during both
- the Bow Season and the Regular Season until license is filled. Moose Hunting Units M1C and M4 will remain closed in 2022.
