- Licenses will be issued by a lottery procedure through the Department. Applications must be submitted online. The deadline to apply is March 23, 2022.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES FROM LAST YEAR

- A bighorn sheep hunting season is scheduled to open in 2022, unless there is a recurrence of bacterial pneumonia. Applicants may apply for a license at this time, but not in a specific unit. The status of the bighorn sheep season will be determined by September 1. Unit B5 has been created for Bighorn sheep hunting to increase harvest from the Long X & Killdeer WMA herds. Total elk licenses increased by 40 to 563. Total moose licenses decreased by 70 to 404. All moose licensees and Unit E1E, E1W, E2, and E6 elk licensees may hunt during both the Bow Season and the Regular Season until license is filed. Moose Hunting Units M1C and M4 will remain closed in 2022.
